



WHO WE ARE

The Ellensburg Downtown Association is a non profit 501(c)(3) and Nationally Accredited Main Street Program. Our focus is to support our downtown businesses through a proven 4-point approach of Design, Outreach, Economic Vitality, and Promotions. The EDA leverages this Main Street Approach to enable the community to revitalize downtown Ellensburg and foster economic vitality.

MAIN STREET 4-POINT APPROACH

Design (Beautification, Historic Preservation)

Outreach (Fundraising, Awareness, Celebration)

Economic Vitality (Grant programs, micro business support, and downtown economic development)

Promotion (Downtown Storytelling, Business Promotion)

MAIN STREET TAX CREDIT INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Did you know that businesses can keep portions of their tax dollars in our community, vs. sending it to Olympia? The Main Street Tax Credit Incentive Program (MSTCIP) provides a Business & Occupation (B&O) credit for private contributions given to designated Washington Main Street Communities, like Ellensburg, through the Ellensburg Downtown Association.

This program provides 60% of the EDA's annual budget, and plays a major role in downtown revitalization.
